Snowplowing

If you would like your driveway plowed out this winter please stop by the Township Office and sign a snowplow waiver or call the office to request one to be mailed or faxed to you. You must sign a waiver before we can plow your driveway. All outstanding snowplow invoices must be paid prior to the snowplowing season. The cost to get your driveway plowed for 2018 is \$25.00.

Reminder to residents to please make sure your driveways are cleared of debris. For safety reasons we would ask that you remain in your residence when your driveway is being plowed as the equipment is large and visibility can be an issue. Please do not leave snow or bumps on any municipal roadway when plowing your own driveways.
