Landfill

We cannot express enough that our landfill is for the Township of La Vallee residents *only!* There are specific areas designated for wood, tires, metal and electronics. There are also bins for aluminum cans, metal cans and plastic bottles. Please sort your garbage accordingly.

Fire Permits

Fire permits are required January 1st to December 31st yearly. Please ensure you have a valid permit for outdoor wood stoves, burning barrels and for any other outdoor burning.

Snowplowing

If you would like your driveway plowed out this winter please stop by the township office and sign a snowplow waiver or call the office at 486-3452 to request one to be mailed or faxed to you. You must sign a waiver before we can plow your driveway. All outstanding snowplow invoices **must** be paid. The cost to get your driveway plowed is \$25.00.

Reminder to residents to please make sure your driveways are cleared of debris. For safety reasons, we would ask that you remain in your residence when your driveway is being plowed, as the equipment is large and visibility can be an issue. Please do not leave snow or bumps on any municipal roadway when plowing your own driveways.
