Door to Door Fire & Life Safety Information Campaign

The La Vallee Fire Department will be visiting residents to provide information about smoke alarms, carbon monoxide detectors and home escape plans. The visits will take place between 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. on October 3rd, 4th, 10th and 11th. La Vallee Fire Department will have a limited supply of combination smoke/carbon monoxide alarms. Price will be \$55 per combination alarm. (Fire Service is not able to make change or accept cheque/credit. **Cash only.**) *This is not a home inspection by any means, and is only a door to door campaign to pass on fire and life safety information to keep our community safe. Note: Only residential properties North of the CN Tracks will be completed this year. Properties South will be completed during the 2018 calendar year.
