Reminder

The Fire Department would like to remind the community to perform smoke and CO2 alarm checks every month. It is good practice to change the batteries when you change your clocks and when the low battery warning beeps. Smoke alarms should be installed on every level of your home. Smoke and CO2 alarms should be located near sleeping areas. Review your escape plan with your family.

Entrance Permits

Just a reminder that permits are required for any and all temporary and permanent entrances. Applications can be picked up at the Municipal Office.

Fire Permits

Fire permits are required January 1st to December 31st yearly. Please ensure you have a valid permit for outdoor wood stoves, burning barrels and for any other outdoor burning.

Building Permits

With Spring approaching, just a reminder that building permits are required for any building construction within our municipality. If you have any questions as to whether or not you need a permit, please call the municipal office or our Building Inspector, Marc McPherson, at 275-7814.

Snow Removal

Please do not leave snow or bumps on any municipal roadway when plowing driveways. This is a hazard and you will be billed if a mess is left on the roadway and the roads department has to clean it up.

Landfill

There are specific areas designated for wood, tires, metal and electronics. There are also bins for aluminum cans, metal cans and plastic bottles. Please sort your garbage accordingly. If you're not sure where to put your garbage just ask the attendant. Keeping our landfill organized will not only benefit the town but our future generations as well.
