Landfill Attendant Job Opportunity

The Township of La Vallee is inviting applicants for the position of Landfill Attendant. This position is a part-time position with approximately 18 hours per week. Dozer operation experience will be considered an asset and you must have a valid driver's license. Further information may be obtained at the Municipal Office.
