Landfill

There are specific areas designated for wood, tires, metal and electronics at our landfill. There are also bins for aluminum and metal cans. Please sort your garbage accordingly. If you're not sure where to put your garbage just ask the attendant. Keeping our landfill organized will not only benefit the township but our future generations as well. Also, all trailer loads of materials must be sorted. If not, you will be charged a fee.

*The Township receives revenue from the Electronics bin at the landfill and from the scrap pile. So please sort and recycle these items/materials. It benefits all taxpayers.

***Access to the landfill is a privilege so please do not abuse it.**

Building Permits

All building/construction that takes place in the municipality requires a building permit. Moving buildings/sheds etc. onto your property also requires a building permit. Please consult with the Building Official before construction begins or if you have any questions. Building without a permit is subject to a fine.

Missing Signs

Recently there have been signs and posts taken from various roads in the municipality. Also fire numbers and posts. Fire numbers are important for every residence to have. These numbers are how Emergency vehicles find you. When they are missing or not visible, valuable time is wasted in a call for help. Anyone who destroys or removes these numbers and posts will be fined and prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law. Dogs Running at Large

Please be advised that it is your responsibility to keep your pets under control and ensure that they are contained and not running at large this also includes not allowing them to poop on other's property. We receive numerous complaints every year about dogs running at large and bothering others. If complaints are not resolved or continue, the OPP will be involved.

Driveways

It is that time of the year again. If you wish to have your driveway plowed this season please sign a waiver so you can be put on the list. Reminder, driveways will not be plowed on weekends or holidays. Also, the municipal office will be closed the week of December 25th through January 1st. No driveways will be done during that period so please make alternate arrangements.

Heating Safety

Install wood burning stoves following manufacturer's instructions or have a professional do the installation. All fuel-burning equipment should be vented to the outside to avoid carbon monoxide (CO) and maintain CO alarms to avoid the risk of CO poisoning. **FACT**-half of home heating fires are reported during the months of December, January and February.
