Landfill Attendant Position

The Township of La Vallee is inviting applicants for the position of Landfill Attendant. This position is a part-time position with 18.5 hours per week. The Attendant reports directly to the Road Superintendent and is responsible for maintaining and operating the landfill site and conducting a recycle program. Some paperwork is required. Dozer operation experience will be considered an asset and you must have a valid driver's licence. Further information and job description can be obtained at the Municipal Office. Applications in the form of a resume must be received at the Municipal Office by Wednesday, November 13th, 2019 at 4:00 p.m. Mailing address is P.O. Box 99, 56 Church Road, Devlin, Ontario P0W 1C0.

Driveway Snow Removal

As in previous years, the Township of La Vallee will be providing snowplowing of driveways for residents. If you wish to have your driveway plowed, please contact the Municipal Office and we will gladly send you a waiver form to sign. Waivers have to be signed every year and driveways will not be plowed until the waiver is signed. For the remainder of the 2019 year, the cost is \$25.00 per plow subject to change in January 2020.

Please be advised that municipal roads are priority and are always done before any driveway. Driveways are never plowed on weekends nor on overtime hours. The municipal roads are always done the first day of the snowfall (and possibly the second day should there be a huge snowfall) and then the driveways are plowed after all the municipal roads are cleared. Example: if we get a snowfall on a Friday then no driveways will be done until the beginning of the following week.

If you are on the "on-call" list and require your driveway to be plowed, it is **very important** that you call the first day of snowfall to advise that you would like your driveway plowed when they do them. If you wait and call after the equipment has been out doing driveways an additional fee will be charged to have the equipment go out again if time permits.

On-line Bill Payments

Please be advised that when paying bills on-line through CIBC it does not come over into our bank account until the next business day. We just wanted to clarify this as some wait until the last day to pay their property tax bill and when it doesn't come over until the next business day then penalties are already added to your account. Email transfers are also accepted as a method of payment and can be emailed to laivalley@nwonet.net but please remember that we can only accept them during business hours. If you send it after office hours it will not get deposited into our account until we are back in the office. *****Penalties are added to overdue accounts on the first day of every month.***
