The **Municipal Office** remains closed to the public. We are taking appointments for things that have to be dealt with in person. Call the office at 486-3452 to arrange an appointment. **Masks are required** to enter the facility and only one person is permitted inside at a time. We are still encouraging people to use online payments and/or email transfers to make bill payments. If you are sending an email transfer, please contact the office to provide us with the answer to your security question if one is required.

Due to staff availability for proper cleaning/sanitization, the **Devlin Community Hall** and the **Devlin Ball Park** are still closed to the public.

CEMETERY

Our Cemeteries Policy has been updated and posted on our website. Please note that anything done in any one of the Cemeteries has to be pre-approved through the Municipal Office.

Monuments are the responsibility of the family. Any monuments that are leaning will be laid down and stored or removed for safety reasons.

SNOWPLOW

The snowplow waiver for the 2020-2021 season is now posted on our website. The waiver can be signed and either faxed, emailed or dropped off at the office. Please note that a new waiver has to be signed every year. The snowplow rate for this year is \$30/trip (based on 15 minutes). Anything longer than 15 minutes will be based on an hourly rate.

LANDFILL

You may have noticed a new face at the Landfill. On behalf of the Township of La Vallee we would like to welcome Rob Brandrick as our new Landfill Attendant!

Starting October 26, 2020, a new landfill site access card will be required to access the Landfill Site. The yellow cards will no longer be valid nor accepted after this date. Please attend the Municipal Office to pick up a new card and turn in your yellow one. ID will be required. You can attend the office on these days and times to pick up your new card and turn in your old one.

Monday-October 19th from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Tuesday-October 20th from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Wednesday-October 21st from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Monday-October 26th from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Landfill site access cards for renters are the responsibility of the property owner (s) to arrange to have a card made with the tenant(s) name. The office will require written approval from the property owner to create a card for the renter. When renters change, it is the responsibility of the property owner to collect the card and provide the office with written approval for the new tenant to obtain a card.

The landfill site access cards are for residents of the Township of La Vallee **ONLY** and anyone caught giving their card to a non-resident will have their landfill site privileges revoked. This is our landfill and if not properly maintained the end result will be a tax burden on our residents.

Below is a list of resident tipping fees recently updated:

6.1.1. Tire Tipping Fees	No Charge
6.1.2 Refrigerants (propane included)	No Charge
6.1.2.1 Freon drained & tagged	No Charge
6.1.2.2 With freon & untagged	\$ 50.00 per unit

****Has to be tagged or you pay the fee**

6.1.3 Building Products (commercial loaded vehicles)	
6.1.3.1 Tandem load (combustible materials)	\$ 50.00 per load
6.1.3.2 Tandem load (non-combustible)	\$ 50.00 per load
6.1.3.3 Semi-Truck/Trailer load (combustible materials)	\$ 75.00 per load
6.1.3.4 Semi-Truck/Trailer load (non-combustible)	\$ 75.00 per load
6.1.3.5 Dual-axel dump trailers(materials from outside area)	\$ 25.00 per load
6.1.3.6 Oversize Trailers	\$ 150.00 per load

*** All materials must be separated!**

****Contractors** who are residents of La Vallee will be charged the appropriate fee when bringing in materials from outside the municipality. This will be verified and you will be required to sign a form to verify where the materials have come from.

****Residents** can bring shingles/wood products to the landfill free of charge. The material must be separated and dumped in designated area. If you are bringing in **trailer loads** of material then the above fees will be imposed.

Paint cans can be brought to the landfill but only if they are empty or if the contents are solidified.

Do not confront the landfill attendant with complaints or arguments. Direct all your inquiries to the municipal office.
