DRIVEWAYS

Reminder to all individuals who have signed a snowplow waiver- Our municipal roads are the priority when we get snow. Driveways will be done a day or two after the roads have been plowed. Our employees do not work on the weekends!

In the past month we have experienced numerous equipment breakdowns that have required one or two machines to be out of service at once. If you have been inconvenienced, we thank you for your patience and cooperation. We suggest you have a backup plan in place so you are not inconvenienced should this happen again in the future.

LANDFILL

The landfill site access cards are for residents of the Township of La Vallee **ONLY** and anyone caught giving their card to a non-resident will have their landfill site privileges revoked. This is our landfill and if not properly maintained the end result will be a tax burden on our residents.

****Contractors** who are residents of La Vallee will be charged the appropriate fee when bringing in materials from outside the municipality. This will be verified and you will be required to sign a form to verify where the materials have come from.

****Residents** can bring shingles/wood products to the landfill free of charge. The material must be separated and dumped in designated area. If you are bringing in **trailer loads** of material then the fees will be imposed. * **All materials must be separated!**

Paint cans can be brought to the landfill but only if they are empty or if the contents are solidified.

****Do not confront the landfill attendant with complaints or arguments. Direct all your inquiries to the municipal office.**
