SNOWPLOW

New guidelines are being implemented for plowing driveways for the 2022/2023 season. We will no longer have an on-call list. The day or two after a heavy snow and once all the municipal roads are cleared, the equipment will be out plowing driveways. The equipment operator will use their discretion to plow your driveway; if your driveway looks plowed they will not go in. When we plow it will be one swipe up and one swipe down your driveway. The rate for this year is \$30/trip (based on 15 minutes). Custom snowplowing is available for anything over 15 minutes at \$100/hr.

The snowplow waiver for the 2022-2023 season is now posted on our website. They can be signed and either faxed, emailed or dropped off at the office. Waivers can also be picked up at the office. Please note that new waivers have to be signed yearly.

FIRE PERMITS

Fire permits are required yearly from January 1st to December 31st. As the cooler temperature approaches, please ensure you have a valid permit for burning barrels, fire pits and for any other outdoor burning.

Please be mindful of your neighbours when burning garbage. Sometimes it can create a lot of smoke and smell.
