Burn Permits

A reminder that burning permits are required for any type of burning. They can be acquired by visiting our website at www.lavallee.ca. You can pay online or choose to pay by cash, cheque or email transfer. Please be aware that your burn permit is not valid until payment is received. If you choose "pay later" and payment is not received within 10 days, your permit will be revoked.

Fire Numbers

Please note that if someone is caught tampering with Fire Numbers they could be charged with mischief. If this results in a delayed response by Emergency Services and puts someone's life at risk, they could be found guilty of an offence and liable to imprisonment for life.

Building Permits

Building permits are required for any building or renovation done in the Municipality. This also includes decks and structures that are moved on to properties. If you are unsure whether you need a building permit or not, please contact the Building Official.
